Dr. Rhodes' Weekly Message

As the school year continues, we are receiving more Changes of Transportation. In order to keep all paperwork straight and ensure all students are sent home correctly, we need to adjust our system. Starting Monday (1/22), any Changes of Transportation lasting over 1 week, will be processed as a <u>Permanent</u> Change of Transportation. Simply send a note to school when you need to switch the mode of transportation back to the original mode and we will issue another <u>Permanent</u> Change of Transportation. If you have a Change of Transportation lasting 5 days or less, we will continue processing these changes as day to day Changes of Transportation. Thank you for your cooperation.

This semester we are beginning some after school programs. These are paid programs that rent space at Bryant and are independent of Bryant and KISD. The first program is the Katy Robotics Academy. 1st-5th grade students will learn computer programming through LEGO robotics. There will be one 3-week session (6 classes) offered, starting in April. Registration is first come, first served, and space is limited.

Home to School Connection



Think like a historian

Does your child know that history isn't just something that happened a long time ago? In fact, history is made every day. Let him be a historian with this activity.

Find and document

Have him pay attention to historymaking events like "firsts" (his little brother's first steps), unusual



occurrences (the decade's biggest snowfall), or significant changes (moving to a new house). Encourage him to document each event by writing about it or making audio or video recordings.

Analyze and predict

Like a historian, he should analyze why the event is important and what we might learn from it. He might say, "We normally get a dusting of snow in our state, but this week we got six inches," and "Now we know how snow drifts when the wind blows."

Idea: Let your youngster share his historical "document" with your family by reading aloud what he wrote or playing his recording.
