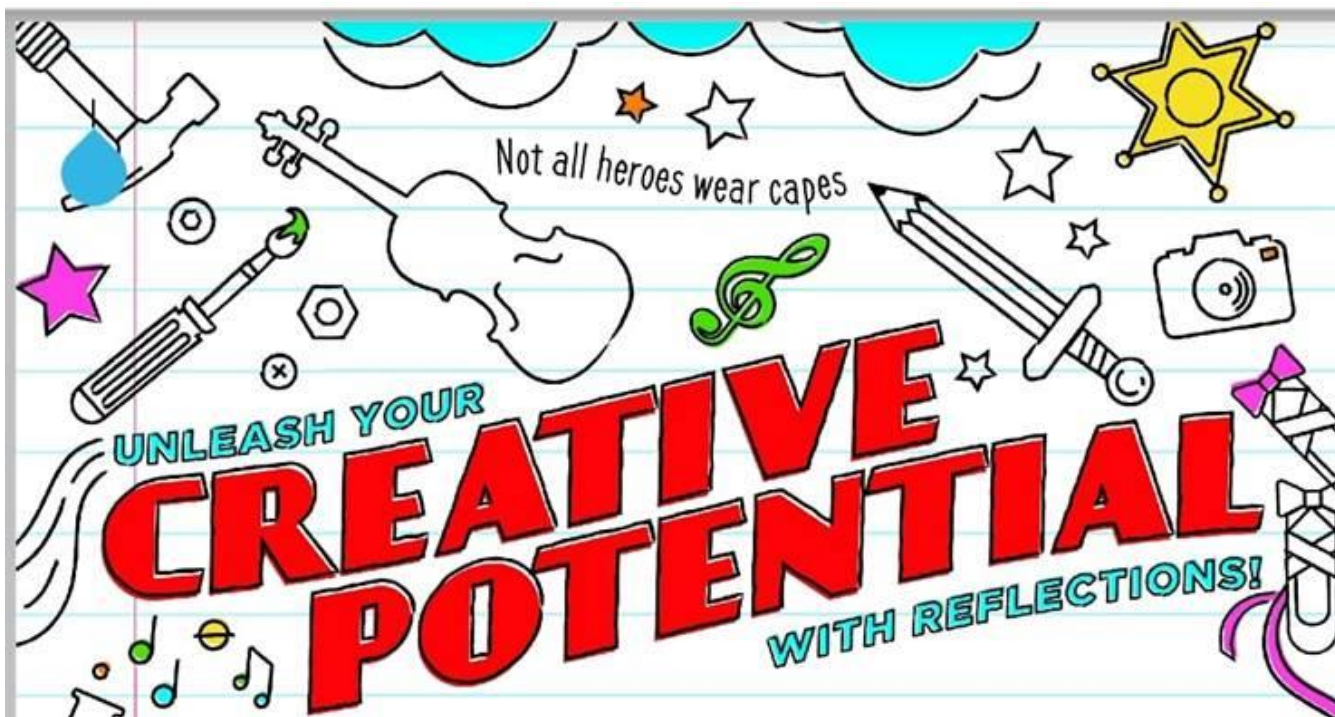
Submit Your Hours!
