# Procedures for Early Dismissal

If you need to have your student released early from school for any reason, your student MUST bring a note to the front office in the morning. This enables the student to be released from class with a pass at the appropriate time so that we do not disrupt classroom instruction by calling the teacher. The note should include:

- The student's name & grade
- The requested dismissal time
- Name of the person picking up the student

Only parents/guardians listed in PowerSchool may sign out a student. You will be asked to show a photo I.D.

These dismissal procedures also apply to athletes leaving early for sports at CFHS. If your athlete is signing out early please follow these procedures.

If you are entering the building for any reason please park in the parking lot NOT in the traffic circle.

## **Afternoon Transportation Changes**

Any change in your student's afternoon transportation MUST be received in writing by 2:45 PM. This is the most efficient way to ensure that teachers/ students receive notice of the change. They may be dropped off at the front office or emailed to <a href="Mrs. Fehlig">Mrs. Fehlig</a>. Thank you for your cooperation.

# FOOTBALL TRYOUTS ATTENTION RISING 7TH & 8TH GRADE STUDENTS

Football tryouts will be August 23rd-27th from 4-6. If interested please contact Coach Ackerman. If you wish to participate you MUST have a current physical and all of the Horry County Athletics Participation Forms filled out on PLANET HS.

Parents and students are required to create an online account and complete the pre-participation physical packet. The online packet must be completed before any participation in athletic activities will be allowed. To complete this process, please follow the instructions on page 10 of this newsletter.

If your student athlete and the parent already have accounts simply log in and upload the new / current physical and then fill out all the paperwork for the upcoming school year.

Students that played football this year, or any other Horry Country School sponsored sport your physical is current until June 17, 2021. After June 17, 2021 those athletes will need to get a new physical and update then the athlete and parent <a href="PlanetHS">PlanetHS</a> accounts.

# Please note...Per South Carolina High School League rules, pre-participation physicals are valid from April 1, 2021 through the end of the 2021-2022 school year.

# Thinking about playing a sport in 2021-2022? IMPORTANT INFO BELOW!

Dear Parent/Guardian:

In 2017 Horry County Schools implemented a new electronic registration system for athletics. Parents and students are required to create an online account and complete the pre-participation physical packet online. The online packet must be completed before any participation in athletic activities will be allowed. To complete this process, please follow the instructions outlined below.

If you have already completed a parent and student account previously on **PlanetHS** or **ArbiterAthlete**, then simply log in using your same account username and password and complete the required information for 2021-2022. **If you do not remember your account information, please contact the athletic department at your child's school.** 

#### DO NOT CREATE A SECOND ACCOUNT IF YOU HAVE FORGOTTEN YOUR PASSWORD.

Visit <u>www.PlanetHS.com</u> and click "sign up" or "log in". You may also text a school code (see below) to **69274** to sign up. **Do not** create an account or sign any forms before April 1, 2021.

**BOTH** parents and student need to make separate accounts and then **LINK** the two accounts. See below for instructions on how to link parent and student accounts and complete the physical forms online.

#### Athlete/Parent Account Registration and Pre-Participation Form Completion

- 1. Go to www.PlanetHS.com and click "sign up".
- 2. Parent AND Student will need to make separate accounts
  - A. Students, please enter your legal first, middle and last name
  - B. Students, it is recommended that you use your HCS email and password.
    - Ex. Jsmith@g.horrycountyschools.net
  - C. Please chose the high school at which the student will be participating. You may add a middle school later.
- **3.** Once logged in to either parent or student account:
  - A. Complete Emergency Information
  - B. Click Athletic Forms
  - C. Click Athletic Participation
- D. Scroll down and **click "Link Accounts"** and enter the email address or phone number of the parent/student who needs to be linked.
- 4. The other person will receive an email/text to confirm linking accounts. They will see the invite and click "Approve".
- **5.** Once the accounts are linked, you will follow steps B and C again and then scroll all the way to the bottom.
- 6. Click on each of the forms and complete them appropriately.
- **7. PHYSICAL EXAM** form and **BIRTH CERTIFICATE** will need to be uploaded as a document or a clear picture (make sure it is the page of the physical with doctor's signature, we don't need the other pages).
- **8. Both the Parent and Student** will have to click on the links to each form from their separate accounts because both signatures will be required before it will be approved.

If you have any questions, you may contact the Athletic Director or Athletic Trainer for the school at which you will be participating.

# **OBMS Covid-19 Policies & Procedures**

- students must mind their social distancing

# How do I find my bus route???

#### Bus Route Information

#### Step by step instructions for looking up your bus route information

- 1. Go to www.horrycountyschools.net
- From the main page, click on the blue dot with the picture of a bus. This is located about halfway down the page.
- Scroll down until you see <u>Carolina Forest Schools Bus Stop Locator</u>. Click on it to open the map.
- 4. Check box to agree to terms & conditions and click OK.
- 5. On the top left of the page click on this icon
- 6. Click the school selector button to filter your choices. See below:



- 7. Select Ocean Bay Middle from the drop-down menu.
- 8. At the top of the left-hand side of the screen type, in your street address WITH ZIP CODE) and click on magnifying glass.
- 9. Your home will show up as a black dot (.) and the bus stops will be represented by this icon

Click on the closest to your home and this will be your bus stop. It will give you the Bus number and stop location. The arrow on the top left will scroll between AM & PM times.



#### Reminders:

- Please remember the first 2 weeks of school the bus pick/up drop off time is an approximation. Please always arrive at the stop at least 10 minutes prior to the listed times.

#### What South Carolina law says...

Section 59-65-10: State law requires a parent to cause his/her children from age five until the attainment of their seventeenth (17) birthday or graduation from high school, to attend regularly a public or private school.

### **Truancy:**

A student between the ages of 6-17 who misses three (3) unexcused consecutive days or five (5) unexcused total days within a school year is deemed truant and will be placed on an Attendance Intervention Plan (AIP).

If a student is absent unlawfully from school after the AIP conference, the student will be referred to the district's attendance coordinator.

The district attendance coordinator may refer the student to Family Court.

### **Promotion Retention:**

In order to receive credit for a class, students may not miss:

- over five (5) unexcused or unverified class periods of a subject in one semester/term
- or over ten (10) total unexcused or unverified class periods in year-long classes.

Attendance make-up school is offered each semester for students who need to make up a minimum of three absences per class. Make up school is solely for the purpose of obtaining attendance credit.

#### Did you know?

- Lawful absences are considered medical, judicial, bereavement and recognized religious holidays.
- Parents and students have daily access to attendance through PowerSchool which is a helpful tool to keep up with grades and attendance.
- School privileges, such as school transfers, can be denied due to excessive absences or tardies.
- School attendance office cannot complete required paperwork for obtaining a driver's license unless the student is in compliance with the South Carolina Truancy Law.
