Caring for Kids is Different

Children are not just miniature adults.
Children's teeth can be very susceptible to cavities as they come in. The good news is that identifying harmful diet and hygiene habits, along with applying fluoride to teeth can significantly reduce the chance of your child having a cavity. Baby (primary teeth) are important. Primary teeth not only help children speak clearly and chew naturally, they also aid in forming a path that permanent teeth can follow when they are ready to erupt.

Sports Safety

One of the least expensive, smallest, yet most effective pieces of protective equipment available to all athletes is the mouth guard. A mouth guard should be flexible, comfortable, fit properly & be easy to clean. A mouth guard can protect a child's teeth, lips, cheeks, gums & the jaw joint from sports related injuries.

Dental Trauma

If a tooth is knocked out or broken, Remain Calm; then find the tooth or tooth fragments. Place the tooth in milk or contact lens solution; keep the tooth moist (use water if nothing else is available) Call your pediatric dentist as soon as possible.



- The sale of dedications is a fundraiser to help cover the costs of the 5th grade end-of-year celebration.






HUNTER'S GREEN "SOUP-ER" BOWL FOOD DRIVE
