

Freedom Readers Horry County Sites

Freedom Readers is a nonprofit organization that focuses on improving literacy skills for students in low-income areas throughout Horry, Georgetown, and Williamsburg County. The organization offers once-per-week 90-minute sessions for K-5th grade students (known as Scholars) to receive one-on-one attention with a trained tutor. Freedom Readers Spring 2023 Session begins the week of Jan 23rd to March 20th.

Knights for Knowledge

Knights for Knowledge is a one hour, once weekly program that deploys a group of trained tutors to established programs where children gather to help with homework and read with young people on their level. Each Knight is required to volunteer for at least 8 weeks. The goal of the program is to help boost student academic achievement in the wake of the pandemic's impact on learning. Just as the knights of old were called on to be defenders of virtue, our Knights of Knowledge defend every child's right to learn, grow, succeed and read.
