We look forward to partnering with you as we begin the new school year and I wanted to take a moment to provide you with a couple of important dates, required PowerSchool information/updates, and additional items as we prepare for **Raider Day on Wednesday, August 21.** 

## Wednesday, August 21 - Raider Day Registration

Raider Day will be on Wednesday, August 21. If you are unable to make Raider Day, please have your child check PowerSchool for their schedule prior to the first day of school. Current Raider Day registration timeslots are as follows:

- 9<sup>th</sup> grade 8:00-9:30 a.m.
- 8<sup>th</sup> grade 9:45-11:45 a.m.
- 7<sup>th</sup> grade 1:00-3:00 p.m.

Please Note — The parking lot at Davis will not be available during Raider Day on Wednesday, August 21 due to construction. Parents that planned on parking at school will need to park at St. Ephrem Catholic Church off Dodge Park and school buses will shuttle to Davis Junior High via the school bus loop on Plumbrook. If you utilize the shuttle bus system, you will be able to exit the school after completing the checklist at Raider Day and board the bus back to St. Ephrem. If it is a nice day and you want to walk back to your car, that is also an option. Families will enter through Door 8 off the bus loop on the Plumbrook side based on the Raider Day times above. Parents wishing to drop off their students (make sure you pre-register them based on the instructions below) can do so by utilizing the bus-drop off loop located off Plumbrook Rd. No parking or standing will be permitted in the drop-off area.

- Technology Device User Agreement
- Technology Device Insurance Opportunity

Please complete the above steps by 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 20. Completing this process prior to "Raider Day" will speed up your registration on Wednesday, August 21 and will allow more time to move through the other stations during your child's specific times listed above.

If you choose not to complete this step, you will be asked to complete forms at registration as parental signatures are required. Please Note - Students that attend Raider Day and have not pre-registered and come without a parent will not be able to move past the first station without parental signatures on all forms. Students will need to return with a parent or legal guardian to complete the process.
