**Please complete the above steps by 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 19**. Completing this process prior to "Raider Day" will speed up your registration on Wednesday, August 20 and will allow more time to move through the other stations during your child's specific times listed above.

If you choose not to complete this step, you will be asked to complete forms at registration as parental signatures are required. Please Note - Students that attend Raider Day and have not pre-registered and come without a parent will not be able to move past the first station without parental signatures on all forms. Students will need to return with a parent or legal guardian to complete the process.
