


Nassau Community College's Dual Enrollment Program

The Dual Enrollment Program at Nassau Community College (NCC) provides Nassau County high school students with the opportunity to get ahead in their college career and take college-level courses while still in high school!

Qualified students earn high school and college credit concurrently, at a discounted tuition rate. Credits can be applied to Nassau Community College or transferred to most four-year colleges and universities.

Courses are taught in the student's high school during normal school day hours by high school teachers who meet the minimum qualifications of the Nassau Community College faculty. These courses are designed to give high school students the opportunity to experience a challenging, college-level course while still in high school and earn high school and college credit concurrently. Credits can be applied to Nassau Community College or transferred to most four-year colleges and universities.



Student Eligibility Requirements

To participate in the Dual Enrollment Program, students must meet the following requirements:

1

Must be a junior or senior in high school

2

Students in 9th or 10th grade need to be recommended by the school principal, teacher or counselor

3

Must meet the course prerequisite requirements as stated in the College Catalog*

*Requests for enrollment exceptions can be made by the school counselor to the Assistant Vice President for Academic/Student Services and are considered on a case-by-case basis.



The registration period to apply for Fall 2025 and full-year courses is from **June 1, 2025 – September 24, 2025.**

High school students participating in the Dual Enrollment Program are considered registered Nassau Community College students and will have access to the excellent resources the College offers such as the library, Student Services Center, Campus Store, and computer labs.

Once students have completed a dual enrollment course they can request an official transcript from the NCC Registrar's Office and have it sent to their intended college for a review of transfer credit.



Benefits of Dual Enrollment

- ✓ **Cost Savings:** Reduce the overall cost of your college education by earning credits at a discounted rate.
- ✓ **Credit Transferability:** Credits earned can be applied to NCC or transferred to many four-year colleges and universities.
- ✓ **Time Savings:** Get a head start on your college degree by earning credits while still in high school.
- ✓ **Experience:** Receive exposure to college-level coursework and the college environment while still in high school.
- ✓ **Resources:** Receive the perks of being an NCC student including access to NCC resources such as the library and computer labs.

How to Apply



Students interested in taking a dual enrollment course should consult with their school counselor for approval to be considered to take a college-level course(s) at their high school. Students can complete the Dual Enrollment Online Application at: applynow.ncc.edu/register/dualenrollment

TUITION AND FEES

Tuition	\$84 per credit plus applicable course fees. Maximum charge per course: \$168 plus fees.
Application Fee	\$55 (one-time fee)
Consolidated Fee	\$2 per credit (lifetime transcripts)

Note: Students that participate in the Federal Reduced Price Meal Program are eligible for a full tuition waiver.

- Please upload a letter from your high school to confirm eligibility.
- If no verification is provided, your bill will be adjusted to reflect the full fee.

For students attending a school district designated as Community Eligibility Provision (CEP), a federal program that allows schools in low-income areas to provide free or reduced-price meals to all students, a 50% discount will be applied to the tuition rate and the school will provide the required documentation.
