UPDATE#1 SPRING REOPEN

Dear Greece Central Families and Staff:

When I wrote to you last week I said I was confident that we could safely return to four days a week of in-person learning on April 19. I shared that for a few reasons:

- The CDC released new guidance for opening schools
- We continue to hear that New York State officials (NYSDOH) will be updating the opening school guidance that was adopted in August

Updating the New York State guidance is absolutely necessary given we are in a different place with COVID-19. Our community infection rate is low and in school transmission is almost nonexistent. Furthermore, we have learned a great deal from current research and data collected nationally and globally related to social distancing. Unfortunately, New York State officials remain silent on this. The fact that we have all adjusted and changed throughout this pandemic yet the NYSDOH has not changed their guidance is unacceptable.

We continue to plan to reopen on April 19 and I wholeheartedly believe we can do it safely with only one minor adjustment to the guidance. With a reduction in the social distancing requirement from six feet to three feet we believe will be able to safely accommodate our proposed model. Every other COVID safety measure will remain intact.

Today, I along with a collective of Monroe County Superintendents, sent a joint letter to Governor Cuomo and NYS Health Commissioner Dr. Howard Zucker

asking them to follow the science and reduce physical distancing requirements in schools.

We respectfully request that you join us in advocating for an update regarding the ongoing requests for reduced social distancing. In the box (at right) are the contact names, common phone number and email addresses of the NYS Department of Health.

I remain 100% committed to reopening April 19. We can no longer sit idly by waiting for the state to do what's best for students, therefore, we continue to prepare for a return to four-day in-person school weeks. Should the state respond to our reopening plan or release updated guidance, I will reach out with next steps.

Enjoy Spring Break and please remain COVID safe whether you're traveling or staying local.

Spring Reopening Plan Submitted to **State Officials**

Greece Central School District leaders today submitted a formal **Spring 2021** Reopening Plan to New York State officials for review and approval. The plan is modeled after the July 2020 plan Greece successfully submitted before reopening in September. The revised plan maintains all of the original assurance areas and updates language on social distancing to reflect a switch from six feet to three feet. We intend to bring larger numbers of students back to school more frequently in the fourth marking period (April 19) abiding by the assurances as described.

3-8 Assessments Will **Continue This Spring**

Please be advised that New York State is still requiring all districts to conduct 3-8 assessments this spring. Please read the **linked letter** for information about the shortened dates of testing for ELA, math and science. It is important to note that the results of the assessments will not be used as part of the state accountability system for teachers or schools. They provide parents and teachers with a short narrative of each students' strengths and opportunities for growth as related to the competencies measured on the assessment. Parents who wish to refuse any or all of the assessments for their child, must submit a request in writing to the school principal with a listing of any or all of the assessments they are refusing.
