eLearning Student Pledge:

Please communicate with your child's Homeroom teacher that they have read and accept the eLearning Student Pledge by Monday, March 30th. Depending on the grade level: Sign, scan and submit through Google Classroom; sign and send a picture of the pledge to the teacher; or, parents can email the Homeroom teacher that their child understands what is expected of them. Middle School students must submit to the Homeroom teacher by 12:30 p.m., as that will be their attendance for the day.

Daily Attendance:

Homeroom teachers will be taking attendance daily. Attendance for PreK-5th Grade can be shown by attending live sessions, posting assignments on Google Classroom, or emailing teachers to let them know that your child is completing school work that day. Attendance in Middle School will take place between 11:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m. MS Homeroom teachers will post a question on Google Classroom that students must answer. Teachers will post attendance on PowerSchool by 3:00 p.m., daily. If your child is unable to participate, please contact your child's Homeroom teacher, ASAP. For all students marked absent, an automated call will be made each evening to inform you of their absence. No action needs to be taken, unless they were marked absent by mistake.

Just a reminder that the distribution of materials is tomorrow, Friday, March 27th. Please follow the instructions in yesterday's letter.

Chromebooks:
