Student Dress Code

A reminder as the weather gets warmer that Pinewood is an air-conditioned building, and clothes need to be appropriate for a learning environment as stated in our family handbook. Shorts or skirts may be worn to school but need to be "fingertip" length. Tank tops need to be worn with a shirt under or over them. Students may need to bring a sweater or sweatshirt as the temperature does fluctuate in different areas of the building during the day. Fridays are always Pinewood Spirit Day, and we encourage students to show their pride by wearing a Pinewood shirt or wearing green.

Lost and Found

If your child is missing a jacket, shoes, or maybe a lunchbox, please remind your child to check the school's lost and found, located in the main entry of the school. NOTES FROM THE NURSE....

OPS medication policy states no medication can be given at school, even over-the-counter medication, without a licensed health care provider's written order. Please provide the written physician's order and the medication (in the pharmacy labeled container or labeled over-the-counter bottle) to the health office, so we may safely administer the medication to your child. All medications should be picked up by the parents and taken home at the end of the school year.

You may now start scheduling your kindergarten physicals and immunizations. Upon completion, please bring your child's immunization record and physicals to Pinewood Elementary. These are important documents to have on file prior to the first day of kindergarten. If you should have further questions, please contact our school nurse, Mrs. Kroeger at 531-299-1941. Thank you!
