Notes from the Nurse

Fall is almost here, and that means lots of colds and flus. You know that hand washing is important, but have you ever thought about another source

of germs at school: your child's lunch box and back pack? Most are tossed on floors, and then placed on surfaces that need to be clean, such as the lunch table or a desk. It is recommended that you wash your child's lunch box and book bag weekly. Most can be tossed in the washer and dryer (but check the label to make sure!).
