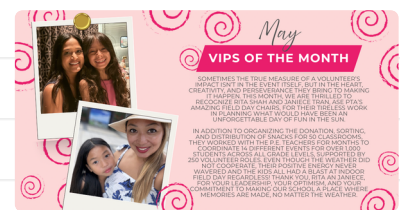
NO PARENT LUNCH VISITS

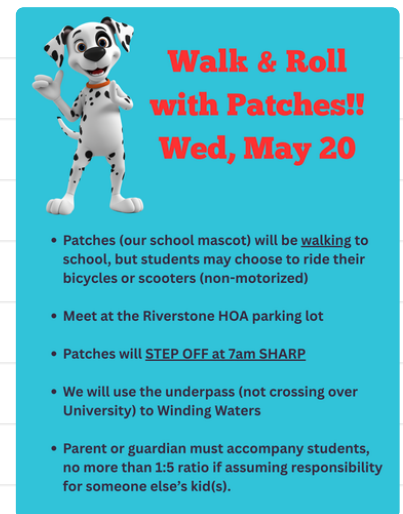
MAY MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH

Join us on May 20th as we encourage all students to walk or ride their bikes to school with Patches.



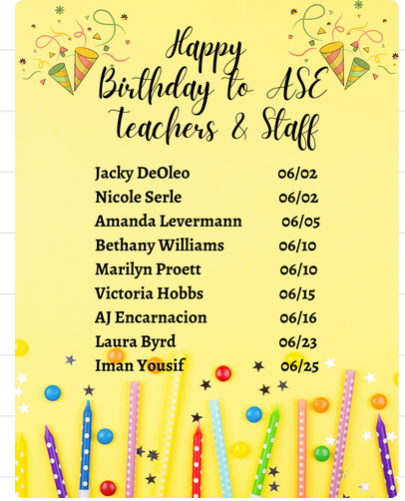

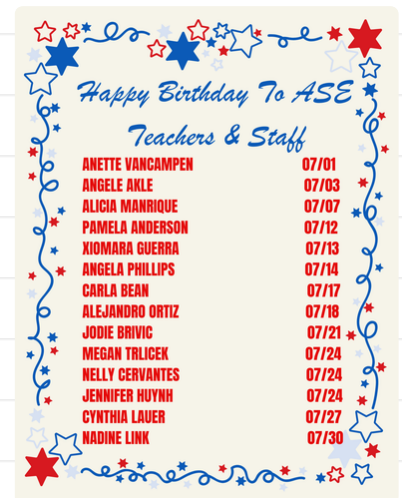

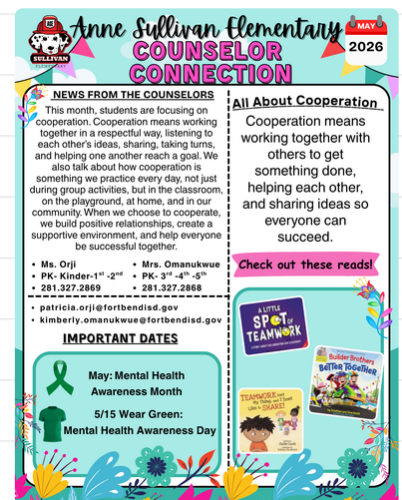
Counselor's Corner: Focus on Cooperation



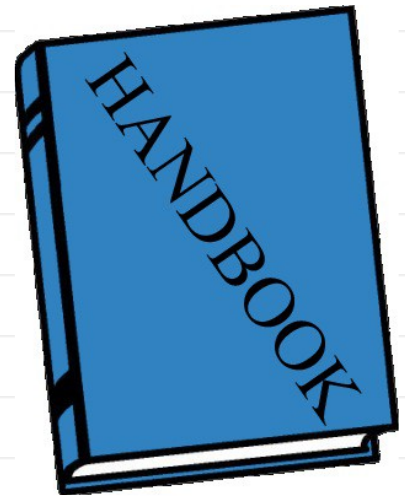
