Traffic Notes

Traffic on rainy days is always congested so be prepared. Supervision is provided by school staff at 8:30 a.m. and the bell rings to enter the building at 8:40 a.m. Students are considered tardy if they are not in their classrooms by the 8:50 a.m. bell. Please plan accordingly, and if you live in a bus zone we strongly encourage you to utilize it! If you are driving to pick up your student on the upper blacktop, we ask you to wait in a parking space until all your children are waiting out front, once you see your child you can get you into the circling cars. Kindergarten parents are the only ones who will continue to circle the lot until they see their child. If you are one of those waiting or stuck on Old Bonhomme Road, you may decide that it would be quicker to park at Stacy Park and walk across to pick up by the front library door. If your child is old enough to be responsible, they can walk on the sidewalk and cross over to the park with the help of the crossing guard. If your dismissal plans change, you may call the office before 3:15, to ensure the message is delivered to your child in time. If the change happens and you aren't able to notify anyone, there is a teacher at the library door and on the upper blacktop who can call for your child. Remember, a consistent plan helps everyone get connected more efficiently!
