## WEEK 1 JULY 6TH–JULY 10TH AM CAMPS (9AM–12 PM) SPRINGTON LAKE MIDDLE SCHOOL

### Artists in the Making

**Incoming Grades 1–3**

**Cost: \$165 per week**

This camp emphasizes fun exploration of various media in the world of art. Students can expect to experience a combination of drawing, painting, using papier-mâché, tie-dyeing, printing, stenciling, sewing, clay work, and much more! No prior experience is necessary.
