NCC's Dual Enrollment Program

Nassau Community College's Dual Enrollment Program provides Nassau County high school students with the opportunity to get ahead in their college career and take college-level courses while still in high school! Courses are taught in the student's high school during normal school day hours by high school teachers who meet the minimum qualifications of the Nassau Community College Faculty. These courses are designed to give high school students the opportunity to experience a challenging, college-level course while still in high school and earn high school and college credit concurrently. Credits can be applied to Nassau Community College or transferred to most four-year colleges and universities.



Qualified students earn high school and college credit concurrently, at a discounted tuition rate. Credits can be applied to Nassau Community College or transferred to most four-year colleges and universities.

High school students participating in the program are considered registered Nassau Community College students and will have access to the excellent resources the College offers such as computer labs, library, student services center, book store, etc.

Once students have completed a dual enrollment course they can request an official transcript from the Registrar's Office and have it sent to their intended college for a review of transfer credit.

Student Eligibility Requirements

To participate in the Dual Enrollment Program, students must meet the following requirements:

1

Must be a junior or senior in high school

2

Students in 9th or 10th grade need to be recommended by the school principal, teacher or counselor

3

Must meet the course prerequisite requirements as stated in the College Catalog*

*Requests for enrollment exceptions can be made by the school counselor to the Assistant Vice President for Academic/Student Services and are considered on a case-by-case basis.

How to Apply



Students interested in taking a dual enrollment course should consult with their school counselor for approval to be considered to take a college-level course(s) at their high school. Students can complete the Dual Enrollment Online Application at applynow.ncc.edu/register/dualenrollment.

Tuition and Fees

Tuition	\$80 per credit plus applicable course fees. Maximum charge per course: \$160 plus fees.
Application Fee	\$55 (one-time fee)
Consolidated Fee	\$2 per credit (lifetime transcripts)
