What happens if your child spills a milk in their lap at school? They go to the Health Office for a change of pants. There are many reasons a student might need a clean pair of pants at school, so we go through a lot each week. Attendance Counts

The district requires that any student who arrives after the 8:50 bell be marked as late for school. If the school has not heard that the student will be late, they are marked as unverified so a call we be made to inform the family that the student was late. Calling the office before 9:30 am will prevent a call being made. Attendance is tracked by minutes so late arrivals and early dismissals will count against a student's total attendance.
