- 2. Drop-In Academic Support and Tutoring Services: Extra help will be available for students in math, English, science, social studies, and world language courses starting next Tuesday. Extra help will be provided on Tuesday-Thursday from 2:45-3:45 PM so students are able to take an activity bus home after receiving help. This extra help service is provided free of charge to all students and students do not need to make an appointment for extra help. This extra help is a great opportunity for students who need assistance with homework, studying for a test, preparing for midterms, or catching up due to an absence.
- 3. 2024-2025 Course Guide and Scheduling Process for Next Year: The online course guide for the 2024-2025 school year is now available on the district website under the Department of Academics. This online guide provides detailed course descriptions for all core and elective courses offered at Churchill Junior High School and East Brunswick High School. We will be sharing additional information related to the scheduling process with students during homeroom on January 8th and 9th. Information and resources related to scheduling can be found on our school homepage and our school counseling webpage. The online course request module for next year scheduling will open in Parent Access on Wednesday, January 10th and will remain open through February 21st. I want to stress that submitting course requests early in the scheduling process does not prioritize or guarantee a spot in a class for next year. Please take time to discuss scheduling requests with your child before submitting your selections. School counselors will meet with students later this winter and in the spring to review course selections before that information is used to begin building student schedules.
- 4. Midterm Exams: Midterm exams will take place on January 23-26 at CJHS. Most 7th grade students will not take a formal midterm exam except for a few classes such as Algebra I Honors. Some 7th grade classes may administer a common assessment during the exam period to assess student learning from marking period 2. Other 7th grade classes may use the exam period to continue with regular instruction. 7th grade teachers will be communicating with their classes about the format of any assessments for the end of marking period 2. Exam days are single session days for students with dismissal at 12:32 PM. No lunch is served on exam days for grades 7-12. The schedule that we will use on midterm exam days is shown on the next page.
