Dear Parents/Guardians,

The New Jersey Department of Health updated the Guidance for K-12 Schools on December 15th, 2021. Please note that as of today, January 7, 2022, the guidelines below are what the district will be following:

If your child is considered a close contact to a COVID-19 positive individual:

- 7-Day quarantine with testing
 - Unvaccinated persons can end quarantine after Day 7 after receiving a negative COVID-19 test result collected between Day 5 and Day 7. Quarantine cannot be discontinued earlier than after Day 7.
- 10-Day quarantine without testing
 Unvaccinated persons can end quarantine after Day 10 if they haven't been tested for COVID-19.
- Fully vaccinated individuals do NOT need to quarantine after contact with someone who had COVID-19 unless they have symptoms. However, they should get tested 5-7 days after their exposure, wear a mask indoors in public for 14 days following exposure or until their test result is negative, and get tested and isolate immediately if experiencing COVID-19 symptoms. An individual is considered fully vaccinated 2 weeks after their 2nd dose of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine.
- Individuals who tested positive for COVID-19 with a laboratory-confirmed viral test within the previous 90 days and have subsequently recovered and remain asymptomatic do NOT need to quarantine. However, they should wear a mask indoors and self-monitor for COVID-19 symptoms, isolate immediately if symptoms develop, and consult with a healthcare professional for testing recommendations.

If your child tests positive for COVID-19:

- Isolate at home for 10 Days regardless of vaccination status or whether symptomatic or asymptomatic (Until the NJ Department of Health revises their guidelines for K-12 schools to reflect CDC guidelines, we will continue to require a 10 day isolation period at home for all LTPS students & staff.)
- Your child does not need a negative test to return to school after their 10 day isolation period. However, they do need to be improving in symptoms and fever-free for 24 hours without using medication.

COVID-19 Testing: Reminder that the LTPS district will only accept COVID-19 test Rapid (Antigen) or PCR results from a facility/laboratory, home tests are not accepted.

* Please notify your School Nurse if your child is a close contact of a confirmed COVID-19 positive individual, has tested positive for COVID-19, or is experiencing COVID-19- like symptoms.

COVID-19 symptoms:

- At least two of the following symptoms: fever (measure or subjective), chills, rigors (shivers), myalgia (muscle aches), headache, sore throat, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue, congestion or runny nose; OR
- At least one of the following symptoms: cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, loss of taste or smell.



Free COVID-19 testing at the CURE Arena:

The New Jersey Department of Health and Vault is offering free COVID-19 testing at CURE Insurance Arena, 81 Hamilton Ave., Trenton. No appointment is necessary. Testing is for anyone ages 2 and up who lives, works, or goes to school in New Jersey. Test type is based on availability. The schedule is as follows:
