






College Application Process at Lakeville South







If the College/University requests a teacher recommendation letter: (1) ask the teacher, (2) give him/her the <u>Letter of Rec Info Sheet</u> & (3) include a stamped envelope addressed to the institution.




Requesting Transcripts

NON-"Common Application" process









- Set up an account with Parchment for submitting your transcript electronically <u>www.parchment.com</u>
- Complete the online college application and submit the application fee to the college
- Give completed Letter of Recommendation form and envelopes with stamps addressed to college

- ✓ Scholarship search sites




