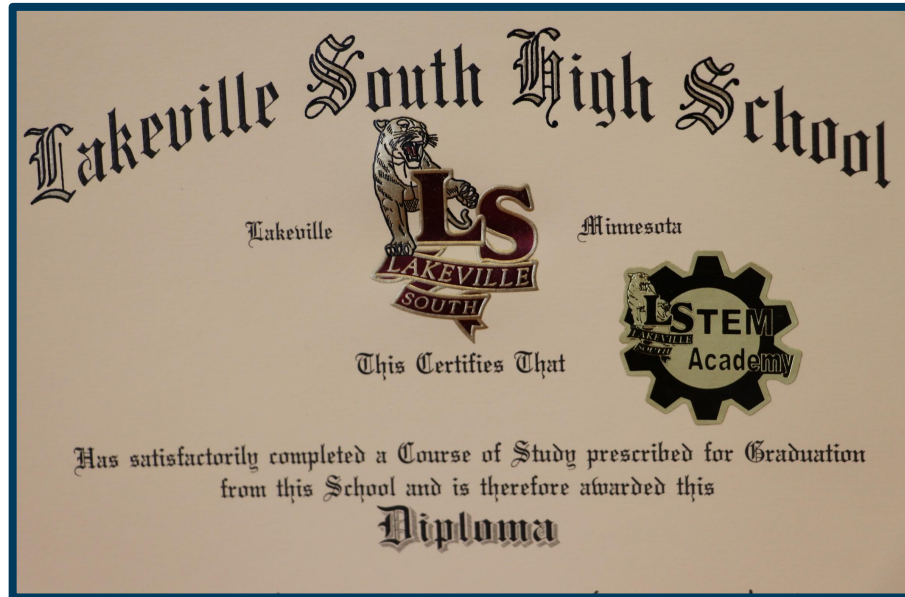

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# Lakeville South College Application Process

Create a transcript account on

Identify colleges/universities & determine what type of application.

Complete application online- Assign your dean on the *School Forms* page & request your transcript through Parchment <https://www.parchment.com/>

Complete application online- Request your transcript through Parchment <https://www.parchment.com/>

The deans complete school report online, including character reference & recommendation. Students must complete the requested information at the [Request for Recommendation Form \(found on LSHS website\)](#).

If any additional information is required (ie. Secondary School Report), bring the forms to Angie in Student Services.

To request a teacher evaluation (TE) on Common App: (1) ask the teacher, (2) give him/her the [Letter of Rec Info Sheet](#), (3) submit the [teacher's email address](#) (found on LSHS website) on the Common Application.

If the College/University requests a teacher recommendation letter: (1) ask the teacher, (2) give him/her the [Letter of Rec Info Sheet](#) & (3) include a stamped envelope addressed to the institution.



If the College/University require a mid-year report or a first semester transcript, request a "next grading period" transcript on <https://www.parchment.com/>
