Voluntary Transfers: March 1 Deadline

Voluntary school transfers are requests from parents for their student(s) to attend a school other than their designated home attendance area school. The voluntary transfer form is due by March 1 to the Educational Services Center (1725 N. Dodge Street, lowa City) and can be found on the District's website.

Transportation: April 1 & June 1 Deadlines -

- Mandatory Busing The district shall provide transportation as required by the State of Iowa (Iowa Code 285.1.a). Elementary students are eligible for transportation if they live more than two miles from their designated school. Please notify the transportation office by April 1 at (319) 688-1187 if you would like your student to ride the bus next school year.
- **Pay-to-Ride Busing** This program is provided on a space-available, time-available, first-come, first-served basis. The program is only available on existing bus routes and at existing stops. Please notify the transportation office by June 1st at (319) 688-1187 if you would like your student to ride the bus next school year.

- Kindergarten Registration & Roundup: February 28 and April 18

- Kindergarten Registration This is scheduled for February 28 from 7:40 AM 7:10 PM. Children must be age 5 by September 15, 2019 to attend kindergarten. Please register at your home attendance school. Grant Elementary families will register at the North Liberty Community Center (520 W Cherry Street, North Liberty). Hoover Elementary (1355 Barrington Road, Iowa City) families will register at the current Hoover Elementary School (2200 East Court Street, Iowa City).
- Kindergarten Roundup This is scheduled for April 18, from 2:30 3:30 PM. This time is planned for both incoming kindergarten students and their parents to come to the school. Grant Elementary kindergarten roundup will take place at the North Liberty Community Center. Hoover Elementary (1355 Barrington Road, Iowa City) kindergarten roundup will take place at the current Hoover Elementary School.

For families and students who will be impacted by boundary changes, opportunities will be available to learn more about the elementary school to which you have been newly assigned.

- Tour/Open House Please plan to attend the open house at the elementary school to which you have been newly assigned on April 4 from 5:30-6:30 pm. Hoover Elementary (1355 Barrington Road, Iowa City) families will meet at the new school. Due to renovation work taking place, Mann Elementary families will meet at North Market Square Park (600 Fairchild Street, Iowa City). Lincoln Elementary families will meet at Horn Elementary (600 Koser Ave., Iowa City) on April 3 at 6:00 pm. Grant Elementary families will meet on August 21, from 5:30 6:30 pm, at the school (1000 N. Bend Drive, North Liberty).
- Elementary Principal & Counselor Visits Elementary principals and counselors will visit with students who will be attending their school in the fall. This will occur in the month of April during the school day at the students' current buildings.
