Dear Parent(s) or Guardian(s):

During the period beginning Monday, March 4 and ending Friday, April 19, Indian Prairie Community Unit School District 204 students enrolled in third through eighth grade will be completing the *Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR)* assessments. Alternatively, students with significant educational needs in grades three through eleven will complete the *Dynamic Learning Maps – Alternative Assessment (DLM-AA)* within the Wednesday, March 13 through Wednesday, May 8 window.

The IAR assessment is an online group-administered achievement test designed to measure student proficiency relative to the *Illinois Learning Standards*. The DLM-AA measures student performance on standards aligned to the *Common Core Essential Elements*. As mandated by the United States Department of Education, public school districts in the State of Illinois are required to assess all students in the above grade levels for the purpose of educational accountability.

Students will be assessed in the achievement areas of English Language Arts/Literacy (ELA/L) and Mathematics. **Individual students are not engaged in assessment during the entire test window.**
