OB Dismissal Traffic Update

Please review the dismissal procedures below, especially on the upper blacktop. Some of the procedures that have been put in place are not being followed and it is making our PM dismissal difficult and at times unsafe. In addition to reading these, please be courteous to other drivers as well as staying off your cell phone when dismissal begins and cars are

moving. We are asking that you review these and ask questions if clarification is needed. Dr. Taggert or Dr. Riesenmy will be on the Upper Blacktop to help enforce these procedures as well. Thank you!

The Front Circle Drive

The front circle drive is one way only and not available when buses are present. Please do not use this for student drop off when the chain is pulled. It should also not be used for student pick up as we need the entire circle for our buses in the PM.

The Upper Blacktop

The parking places along the fence and in the middle of the blacktop need to be filled. If there is an open parking spot, you will be directed by a staff member to park in the space.

- Back into spaces along the fences.
- All cars parked in center spaces should be facing Old Bonhomme Road which means the cars on the playground side pull in and cars on the road side back in. No one should back into any traffic lanes. There must be forward motion only on the blacktop for student safety!
- Kindergarten car riders are not dismissed until 3:47. The rest of the students are not dismissed until the bell at 3:50. If the lot is full, please park at Stacy Park and walk over or wait until the traffic clears. The staff will wait with your child.

Share the Old Bonhomme Dismissal Map and Procedures in the Parent Handbook with others who help with student pick-up. There is nothing more upsetting to everyone than seeing a frustrated grandparent or relative trying to manage carpool. You might want to consider asking them to park at Stacy Park and walking over to pick up.
