A MESSAGE FROM THE NURSE



Parents of 11th grade students Idaho School Immunization rules were updated during the 2020 legislative sessions. A 12th grade meningococcal vaccine is now required starting with the 2020-2021 school year.

New Requirement:

Students who received their first dose of meningococcal (MenACWY) vaccine before the age of sixteen (16) must have two (2) doses of meningococcal (MenACWY) vaccine.

Students who received their first dose of meningococcal (MenACWY) vaccine at sixteen (16) years of age and older, or those who have never received a dose, must have one (1) dose of meningococcal

(MenACWY) vaccine.

If you have questions, please contact your primary provider as soon as possible. Per updated Idaho State law, your child will not be allowed to attend school until we receive an updated immunization record. If you are unable to reach your primary care provider at this time, alternative resources for obtaining this vaccination are listed below:

PROM DETAILS FOR JUNIOR /SENIOR STUDENTS

The Village in Meridian has kindly offered their venue to host prom for all West Ada schools this year. We will of course follow Covid 19 regulations and mandated distancing policies as best we can. Mountain View's Prom will be held June 25th from 8-11 PM. Tickets are available for purchase through myschoolfees.com at a cost of \$10.00 per person. Early purchase is recommended so we will be able to report attendance to the Village and its vendors. Restaurants will be open to provide a pre-prom food option. Prom is traditionally a junior/senior dance, underclassmen may attend if accompanied by a student with junior/senior status. Guests from other high schools may accompany a Mountain View junior/senior but must present ID at entrance.



GRADUATION UPDATE:

June 6th at 11AM, a virtual graduation will take place. A link will be sent out for families to be able to sign in and watch.

The physical graduation will take place at MVHS beginning at 1 PM, June 6th. Families are invited to join their graduate. Two car will be permitted per family, if necessary– please immediate family members only. Decorate your cars and caps and come celebrate our 2020 grads. It is HIGHLY recommended you enter campus via Millennium Drive off Overland. Cars will be staged in the football parking lot on the east side of the school (see map next page), the alphabet will be distributed throughout the afternoon to avoid long waits and traffic congestion.

G-J arrive at 2pm K-N arrive at 2:30pm

O-S arrive at 3pm T-Z arrive at 3:30pm

Cars will follow a route to the front of the school where they will be allowed to park in the front parking lot in designated area (a few families at a time), the graduate will wait in line, selfie stations will be available at several locations, the graduate's name will be called, the graduate will walk across the stage to receive his/her diploma. Families are encouraged to film, take pictures, and cheer their graduate on - there will be professional photos taken as well. Families will be asked to exit the graduation area by return to their cars and exit the parking lot, so other families will have the space to cheer on their graduate. We understand nothing can replace the traditional ceremony honoring graduates, however, we are hoping to create a fun environment to recognize and celebrate our grads. Please respect the social distancing protocols we must follow and exit the graduation area as quickly as possible to accommodate other families so they too may enjoy the experience.
