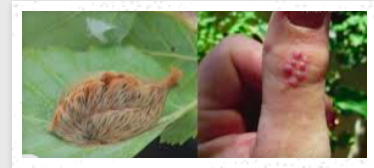

Asps like to hide out in trees too...so if one drops down and lands on a student, their hairs can dig into the skin and cause intense pain.

Unfortunately most stings come from accidental exposure. If someone complains of a red swollen welt initially, this may be a sign of a sting. The pain usually sets in a bit later.

We have alerted our staff to the return of these pesky visitors and have a plan of action in case a student is stung to provide care effectively.

- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
- Loss of taste or smell
- Cough
- Difficulty breathing
- Shortness of breath
- Fatigue
- Headache
- Chills
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Shaking or exaggerated shivering
- Significant muscle pain or ache
- Diarrhea
- Nausea or vomiting

MEALS AT NO COST FOR ALL HUMBLE ISD STUDENTS: 9/28-12/18

Child Nutrition will offer Meals at NO Cost for all Humble ISD students and children ages 1-18 from September 28th- December 18th. Please see below for more details. I have asked Public Communications to help share this with families.

Students on campus for in-person instruction-

- **No Cost Meals** - All Humble ISD students, regardless of meal eligibility (free, reduced, or full paid), will be able to receive 1 breakfast meal and 1 lunch meal per day at NO Cost from any of the menu lines.
- Regular a la carte items will still be available each day for purchase.

Virtual learning students & ALL children ages 1-18

- **No Cost- Curbside Meals To Go - Mondays & Wednesdays from 9:00am-10:00am.**
- All virtual learning students regardless of meal eligibility (free, reduced, or full paid), will be able to pick up curbside meals at NO Cost
- ALL children in the community ages 1-18 may pick up curbside meals at NO Cost
- Mondays: two breakfast meals and two lunch meals will be distributed
- Wednesdays: three breakfast meals and three lunch meals will be distributed

With the exception of Kinder, walkers walk out of the building, guided off campus by staff and walk home without SWE staff supervision. **Parents should not park and walk up to meet their walkers.** Students can meet parents in a spot off campus but will not be supervised while they wait to connect. If supervision is needed, students should be marked a car rider.

SWE RAINY DAY DISMISSAL

Thank you to all our families for their support with dismissal. Texas weather can be unpredictable and change quickly. We appreciate your support as we want all our Stars to be as safe as possible.



- We will call a "rainy day dismissal" in the event of hazardous weather conditions (lightning, thunders, torrential rain, etc...) With light rain and no other dangerous conditions, Walkers/Bikers will be released.
- Parents will be notified by text message. Please make sure that your phone number remains updated in HAC.
- Daycare, YMCA and Car Riders will dismiss as normal.
- Bikers and Walkers will be held in their classroom until released to parents at car rider or dismissed to safely walk /ride home.

LEARNING LOCATION CHANGE FORM INFORMATION

Humble ISD aims to be flexible with allowing families choice for either on-campus or long-term online in a virtual setting. We are proud of all of our staff, and we are happy to know that these two learning options are supporting all of our students as we deal with Covid-19 safety recommendations.

However, if you decide to change your child's learning location, **parents need to complete the Learning Location Change Form** (link below). Please do not email the teacher as the

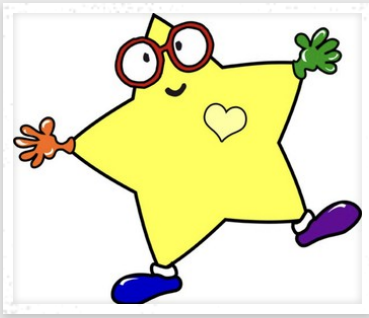
