EVERY MINUTE MATTERS

In CMCSS and at Sango Elementary School, we know that every single minute of the school day matters. Missed time in class means missed instruction, which could result in learning gaps. We understand that children get sick and that things happen, but we ask that you to make all appointments after school and have your child in school whenever possible.

One may think that missing one or two days a week doesn't sound like much. What about if your child arrives ten minutes late or is dismissed 10 minutes early? The chart below outlines the impact that a few days or minutes can have on your child.

One or two days a week doesn't seem like much, but...

If your child misses...	That equals...	Which is...	And over 13 years of schooling, that's...
1 day every 2 weeks	20 days per year	4 weeks per year	Nearly 1 1/2 years
1 day per week	40 days per year	8 weeks per year	Over 2 1/2 years
2 days per week	80 days per year	16 weeks per year	Over 5 years
3 days per week	120 days per year	24 weeks per year	Nearly 8 years

How about 10 minutes per day? Surely that won't affect my child?

Transportation Information



- We are unable to take transportation changes over the phone.
- If there is a change in your child's transportation, a note must be sent to your child's teacher each time. (For example: If a student is to go to car circle every Friday, s/he will need a note for each Friday. If a child rides the bus only on Tuesday and Thursday, s/he will need a note on Tuesday and Thursday.) This is for the safety of your child and to ensure everyone goes to the correct location at the end of each day.

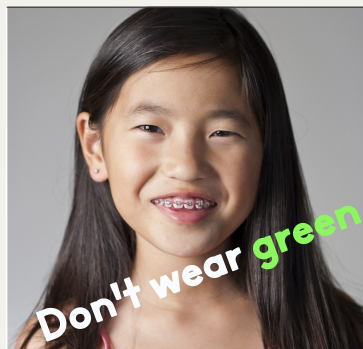

Easy Ways to Help
