Nurse Notes

<u>Flu</u> continues to affect the community of Greentree and Kingwood. Influenza (also known as the flu) is a contagious respiratory illness caused by flu viruses. It can cause mild to severe illness. The flu is different from a cold. The flu usually comes on suddenly. People who have the flu often feel some or all of these symptoms:

- · Fever\* or feeling feverish/chills
- $\cdot \ {\rm Cough}$
- $\cdot \operatorname{Sore} \mathsf{throat}$
- $\cdot$  Runny or stuffy nose
- $\cdot$  Muscle or body aches
- $\cdot$  Headaches
- $\cdot$  Fatigue (tiredness)

• Some people may have vomiting and diarrhea, though this is more common in children than adults. \* It's important to note that not everyone with the flu will have a fever. Please be sure to keep your child home until fever free (without fever reducing medication) for 24 hours, and until he or she is able to resume a full day at school. <u>Strep Throat</u> also continues to infect our kids at Greentree. Please watch for signs of sore throat, difficulty swallowing, stomach ache, or headache. There does not have to be a fever with Strep throat and many of the cases this year have not had the fever. If your child is diagnosed with strep throat, he must be on antibiotics for at least 24 hours before returning to school. Continue to encourage <u>good</u> <u>handwashing</u> for all of your family members.
