Jackets or Sweaters (Outwear)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be worn with an appropriate uniform shirt underneath 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No inappropriate wording or designs on the clothing.
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All shoes must be closed toe and closed heel • Sneakers or athletic shoes are required on P.E. days 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sandals, flip-flops, crocs, or heels. • Boots may be worn on rainy days only
