Dear Academic Magnet High School,

Well, there goes July! I hope everyone is still enjoying the summer break. In my previous letter, I covered the 2023-24 CCSD Academic Calendar, Summer Scholars Institute, Residency Verification, our 2023-24 Bell Schedule, our 2023-24 School Counselor Assignments, School Lunches, Fall Sports, and our AMHS Parent Organizations. Today's letter will cover school supplies, student lockers, student Chromebooks, fees, textbook and schedule pick-ups, student pictures, and student parking. **School Supplies-**

Because this upcoming week-end is tax free back-to-school shopping, we have been getting some questions about specific school supply needs. At a high school with specialized course work, the supplies vary by class, but all students will need the normal resources of high school students- a binder, looseleaf paper, notebooks, pens, pencils, a backpack, etc. Any student or family who needs support at any time with school resources should please see their assigned counselor.

**Student Lockers-**

Every interested Academic Magnet High School student is issued a locker. We spend extended time in our homeroom classes in the first weeks of school and lockers are assigned at that time. Because this may not happen immediately, students should look at their schedules to separate A and B Day class books and materials so that they are not carrying all their school materials. The first day of school, Wednesday, August 23<sup>th</sup> will be an A day.

**Student Chromebooks-**

Every interested Academic Magnet High School student is issued a chromebook ([HP X360 Chromebook G3 32 bit 8 GB device](#)). All families who elect to checkout a device for the year should review the user agreement at [CCSD Acceptable Use Permission](#). To request a chromebook, please just [fill out this form](#) before August 4<sup>th</sup> and we will have the device and charger ready for you when you come to collect your schedule and books next week.

**Student Parking-**

11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> graders who will be driving to school should secure a parking spot by paying the student parking fee in RevTrack. We will issue parking spots on a first come, first serve basis next week. Students can select a specific parking spot and collect their required parking stickers when they come to school for textbook and schedule pick-up next week. After we verify that a student has paid the parking fee in Revtrack, and has completed their residency verification, we will issue a numbered parking spot. This will be done in Room 7108 (Ms. Knox's office) from 9am-3pm Monday-Thursday next week.
