


CONGRATULATIONS to our GTE Spelling Bee Winners!

Kinder G/T Referrals

Kindergarten students may be referred by the parent(s), peers, teacher(s), other professional personnel, and/or themselves. Starting this year, there will be an online district testing portal. This portal will only be open during the assessment window(s) and will include parental permission to test, evaluate, and receive gifted program services. *All* kindergarten students will be screened, and parents will be notified if referral for assessment is recommended based on the results of the screener. Parents of students who have been referred by individuals other than their parents will be contacted to complete the online referral form. No student may be denied access to the Humble ISD Gifted and Talented Program on the basis of race, creed, or handicapping conditions. Referrals should be completed in the online portal on the Advanced Academics website. The portal will be available and open during the referral window December 2 - January 10. Thursday, January 23- "Put Bullying to Bed!" Wear pajamas to show that you are tired of bullying and will not allow it at GTE!


Friday, January 24- Wear your clothing inside out and crazy hair to show that you are a good friend on both the inside and the outside.
