A Message from the Principal:

Starting tomorrow, (Monday, February 22nd), we are excited that students attending school for in-person instruction will now be coming for two days a week – either Monday and Tuesday or Thursday and Friday. I know that many parents have reached out about having their student attend school all four days during the week, however we are not able to accommodate this request. Due to the guidelines that have been communicated to us by the Cecil County Health Department and Cecil County Public Schools, we are only able to safely bring our students back for two days a week of in-person instruction. If you have any questions about our students returning to school, please feel free to contact the main office at your earliest convenience.

Also, on Thursday of this week, we will be officially ½ way through the third marking period. Students need to make sure that continue to attend all of their classes on a daily basis and complete/submit all of their assignments. As you view your student's grades this marking period, please pay extra attention to any grade that is a 45%. This actually means that this assignment has yet to be completed by your student or submitted to their teacher. Rather than continue to penalize students by putting a 0% in the gradebook for missing assignments (many of which have actually been started or completed), teachers will now be entering a 45%.

<u>GRADUATION 2021</u>: We are excited to announce that our graduation for this year's senior class has been scheduled for Friday, June 4 at 5:30 (Rain date will be Saturday, June 5th at 10:30). However, the logistics and details concerning the format and how many family members will be permitted to attend have not been finalized (this will all depend on current guidelines form the Cecil County Health Department). As we continue to get updates concerning this year's graduation, we will make sure that to communicate them with our students and families in a timely manner.

<u>Black History Month:</u> In continuing with our celebration of black history month, we would like to honor Alfred B. Hilton.

Sgt. Alfred B. Hilton, who was born a free Black man in Havre de Grace in 1842 and became the national flag bearer for Company H of the 4th U.S. Colored Troops. While serving as a Sergeant in the Civil War for his Company, he participated in the Battle of Chaffin's Farm, just outside of Richmond Virginia. As he carried the American Flag during the battle, Hilton was shot in the leg and was unable to continue. However, he called upon several of his fellow soldiers to carry the flag forward in battle.

Sergeant Hilton died from his wounds a moth later on October 21, 1864. Six months after the battle, Hilton was posthumously issued the Medal of Honor for his actions during the Battle of Chaffin's Farm. To this date, he is the only native Harford Countian to have received the Medal of Honor, the highest military honor in the county,

Thank you Sgt. Alfred B Hilton, for you for your service and to the sacrifices that you made for our country!

<u>School Attendance</u>: A reminder to all of our students and parents that a student's attendance in each course of enrollment will be used to determine a student's daily attendance. In order for a student to be marked present for a full day, they must attend and engage in learning a minimum of 50% of their classes each day. Students that are marked absent from a class can have that changed to being marked present as long as they complete and submit their assignments for the class they missed within 2 school days.

If your student does need to be absent from school, they will need to provide our attendance secretary with a note stating their name, reason for being absent, and the date(s) in which they were absent once they return. <u>Twilight School</u>: To help support more students during the 3rd and 4th Marking Period, Bohemia Manor High School will now be offering virtual Twilight School on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday each week. Those students that need extra help, have a question, or need support completing/submitting an assignment can access Twilight School between 3:00 and 4:00 or 6:00 and 7:00 on the assigned days. Twilight School will begin this week (starting on Tuesday) and students can access the Twilight School by logging into their Schoology account and adding the Twilight School Course (which has the appropriate Blackboard Sessions) using the access code provided below. Below are several important protocols that must be followed:

- 1. Masks, covering the face and nose must be worn at all times
- 2. Students must have a completed Daily Health Screening Form each day to enter the building (a copy of the form is attached to the end of the newsletter)
- 3. Students will be assigned a seat in each classroom and required to sanitize their desk at the end of each class
- 4. Students must follow appropriate social distancing protocols in the hallways and classrooms
- 5. Only two students at a time will be permitted in the restroom at a time
- 6. Students will only be permitted to sit three to a table in the cafeteria and must sit at a green "check mark"
- 7. Water fountains will not be available for students to use. Each classroom will have bottled water available, however students are encouraged to bring their own water bottles

<u>Mask Reminder</u>: We want to remind all of our students that are currently receiving in-person instruction that masks must be worn at all times (and worn appropriately over the nose and mouth) while in the building. The only exception to this is during lunch. Also the CDC has now determined that Gaiter type face covering are not acceptable. Students attending Bohemia Manor for in-person instruction will not be permitted to wear this type of face covering. Those students that come to school wearing a gaiter face mask will be referred to the nurse and an appropriate cloth mask will be provided.

SPRING SPORTS ELIGIBILITY

Because we understand the difficulties that many of our students have been having and that athletics can be a way to help our students improve academically and socially, the eligibility criteria have been adjusted for the start of Spring Sports (March 15th). Please review the criteria below.

- 1. If you earned all passing grades for the 2nd MP, you are eligible to participate in Spring Sports (until MP 3 Report Cards are issued at which time any student with a failing grade will lose eligibility for the remainder of the school year)
- If you failed a course during 2nd MP you are not eligible to participate in Spring Sports. However, you can earn your eligibility back by having all PASSING grades on your 3rd MP interim (MP 3 interims will be issued on March 4th)
- 3. Any student that receives a failing grade on their Marking Period 3 Report Card will no longer be eligible to continue participating during the remainder of the season.
