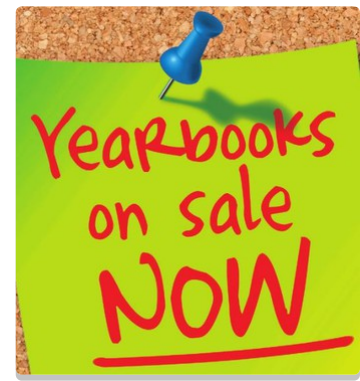

### **Summer Reading**

Don't forget to encourage your students to read throughout the summer. Your child should receive a Readopoly game board to help them track what they read this summer.

Students entering grade 1-3 next year are asked to read, or hear read, 18 books.

Students entering 4th and 5th are asked to read at least 15 books. ( I did tell the students if a book is over 200 pages they may count it in two of the spaces.)

Students that meet their grade level goal, or more will be invited to a Game Day in the library in September. They will also earn a reading charm, a bookmark, and the privilege of checking out an extra book when they visit the library.

If students complete all the boxes they will be entered into a special drawing for books, posters, or a treat. If your child can't find their Readopoly board you may print a new one from the Greentree Library Website!

### Medication Pick-up by 12:00 pm, May 27

**All medication must be picked up by a parent/guardian PRIOR to the end of school on May 27th, 2022 or it will be discarded per district policy. No medication can be sent home with students.**

Please plan to pick up your student's medication anytime during the final week of school. All returns must be signed off by the RN and person picking up, so medication cannot be left at the desk for pick up. Any medications or equipment left in the clinic after 12:00 pm on May 27, 2022 will be discarded.

**Health & Medication forms must be completed YEARLY.** Forms for next year can be accepted if completed/signed after July 1st.
