

Medication Pick-up by 12:00 pm, May 27

All medication must be picked up by a parent/guardian PRIOR to the end of school on May 27th, 2022 or it will be discarded per district policy. No medication can be sent home with students. Please plan to pick up your student's medication anytime during the final week of school. All returns must be signed off by the RN and person picking up, so medication cannot be left at the desk for pick up. Any medications or equipment left in the clinic after 12:00 pm on May 27, 2022 will be discarded.
