Nurse Notes

Wow time has flown by and its February! We have seen a lot of illness here at Greentree in the last month. Lots of Flu, Strep throat and stomach bugs. Please help our kids stay well by dressing warmly, eating healthy, getting exercise, and plenty of rest. And of course, WASH THOSE HANDS. I also can't stress enough about the importance of keeping the sick kids at home.

A few reminders:

Illness- Please keep your child home from school if he has had a fever (100 and over), vomiting, or diarrhea in the last 24 hours. The student must be free from fever without the use of medication for 24hours before returning to school. And even if the fever is gone, please

consider if your child can make it through the school day before sending him back. And finally, have a back-up plan when your child has not been feeling well. We need to have a current phone number to contact a parent or guardian if the student needs to go home.

<u>Medications-</u> ALL medications coming to school **MUST** be delivered to the nurse by an adult. All medications, including over the counter medicine, need a signed authorization form to be completed by a parent before giving it at school. This is for the safety of your child as well as

others. Also...no cough drops may be brought to school. Please help me by following the district policy and procedures. These policies as well as forms can be found on my website.

Injury- Please send a note to school if your child has an injury. This helps us all communicate as to what happened and what expectations we all have with activity at school. A doctor's note with what a child CAN do in PE or recess is very helpful.

<u>Clothing-</u>Please consider sending an extra set of clothes in your child's backpack. Kids will be kids and accidents, spills and puddles are bound to happen- every day! Also please label your child's outerwear. It will help you get it back AND they get a gator ticket for showing me!

As always, feel free to contact me with any concerns you may have with your child.
