Child Nutrition will offer Meals at NO Cost for all Humble ISD students and children ages 1-18 from September 28th- December 18th. Please see below for more details. I have asked Public Communications to help share this with families.

#### Students on campus for in-person instruction-



# Rainy Day Dismissal

Thank you to all our families for their support with dismissal. Texas weather can be unpredictable and change quickly. We appreciate your support as we want all our Stars to be as safe as possible.



- We will call a "rainy day dismissal" in the event of hazardous weather conditions (lightning, thunders, torrential rain, etc...) With light rain and no other dangerous conditions, Walkers/Bikers will be released.
- Parents will be notified by text message. Please make sure that your phone number remains updated in HAC.
- Daycare, YMCA and Car Riders will dismiss as normal.
- Bikers and Walkers will be held in their classroom until released to parents at car rider or dismissed to safely walk /ride home.

# Assignments & Grading

**Elementary Guidelines** 

Students in pre-kindergarten, kindergarten, first and second grades will be evaluated using a developmental continuum (1, 2, 3, or 4). Work samples are collected throughout the nine weeks to assess students' growth towards benchmarks.

For grades 3 - 5, the following grading scale is used to assess reading/language arts, mathematics, science and social studies:

□ 90 - 100 A

□ 80 - 89 B

□ 70 - 79 C

□ 0 − 69 Failing

All students, online or face-to-face, should complete assignments as independently as possible to allow teachers to document growth and mastery on TEKS (Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills) and plan their lessons to meet students' needs.

Grades and progress reports for Grades 3 - 5 are viewable in HAC. If there are issues or concerns, please communicate and collaborate with your child's teacher.

While November 3 is a district allocated day for Parent-Teacher Conferences (No school for students), teachers may schedule a conference from October 16 - Nov. 6. A time via Zoom will be scheduled with every family to discuss student's strengths, challenges and progress.

## **NURSE NEWS**

Welcome back Summerwood Stars to the 2020-2021 school year!

As we prepare to have our students for this school year I just have a few reminders from the nurse:

- All students have to be current with their required immunizations in order to be enrolled, either online, or in person in Humble ISD.
- If a parent chooses, they can request a form, Reason of Conscious, from the State of
  Texas, complete it and have it notarized. The notarized form will then be given to the
  nurse and the child may be enrolled. This process takes time and your child will NOT be
  able to be enrolled in Humble ISD (including online only) until the form is received. To

   Medications will not be accepted without the proper documentation. All medications must be brought to the school by an adult (18 or older). Please review medication policy for any additional questions.

For students interested in skipping a grade next year, testing will be available during the week October 19th-23rd Fall of 2020 we will have testing sessions on campus on October 19th-23rd.




