




IDs are Required for Entry



Habit 1: Be Proactive

Being proactive means taking responsibility for your actions, attitudes, and choices. Instead of reacting to situations or blaming others, proactive students recognize that they are in charge of themselves. they understand that they have the power to choose how they respond to challenges, and that their behavior is a reflection of their character, not their circumstances.

At school this looks like:

- Taking initiative in learning
- Being prepared and organized
- Following through on responsibilities without reminders
- Using positive language like "I can" and "I will"
- Owning mistakes and making things right

We encourage you to talk with your child at home about what it means to "be proactive" and celebrate the ways they show leadership in everyday situations

MULTI-TIERED SYSTEMS OF SUPPORT

All Broward County Public Schools have processes in place to meet student needs in the areas of academic, life skills & wellness and behavioral functioning. Specifically, each school offers a framework that provides varying levels of academic and behavior supports to students based upon their individual needs. This framework is referred to as a Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS).

All school's Collaborative Problem-Solving Team (CPS team) meet regularly to review data and make decisions regarding specific students' need for intervention and/or evaluation. The problem-solving process includes steps that school-based teams use to determine how well students have responded to the instruction and interventions that have been provided. This focused approach of matching interventions to student needs and monitoring them on a regular basis is referred to as Response to Intervention (Rtl). The information gained is used by school personnel to adapt instruction and enable students to be successful in school.

Parent involvement is vital in the process. Please reach out to your child's teacher with questions or clarification.
