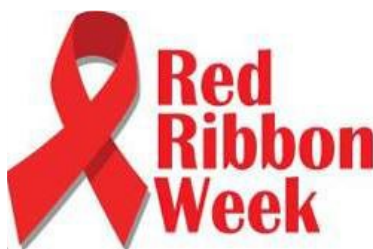

Friday, 10/30; Elect to be a Good Character; Story Book Character Dress Up



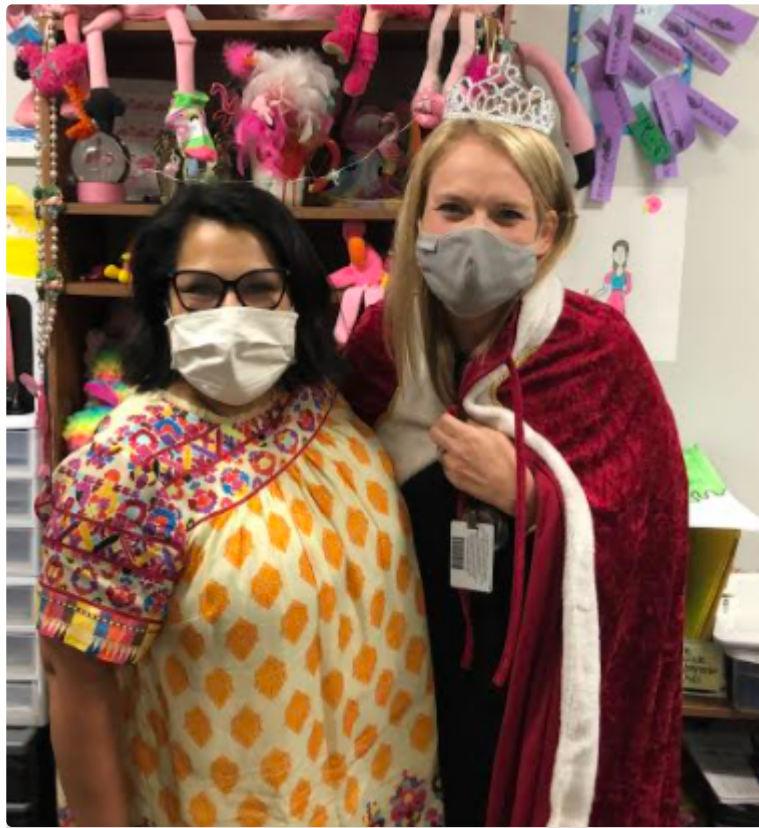
FOOD DRIVE Oct. 26-Oct. 30
