

Asps like to hide out in trees too...so if one drops down and lands on a student, their hairs can dig into the skin and cause intense pain.

Unfortunately most stings come from accidental exposure. If someone complains of a red swollen welt initially, this may be a sign of a sting. The pain usually sets in a bit later.


