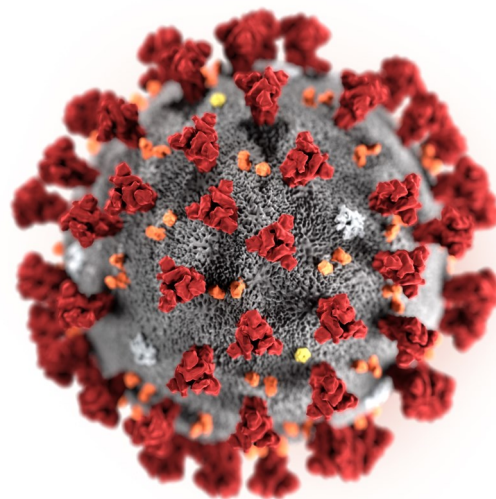

Symptoms If you have any of the COVID-19 symptoms listed below, call your health care provider or one of the listed facilities to request testing. Call in advance so the facility can take steps to prevent exposing others.

- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Fever
- Chills or repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell
