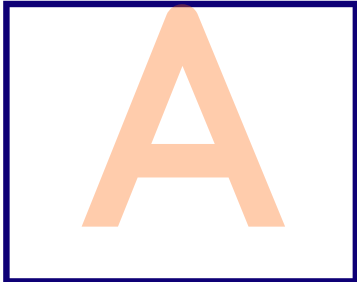

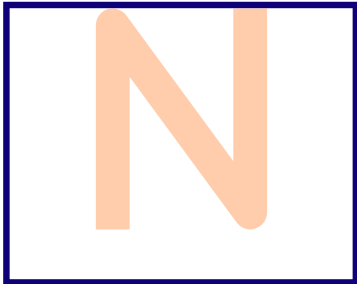

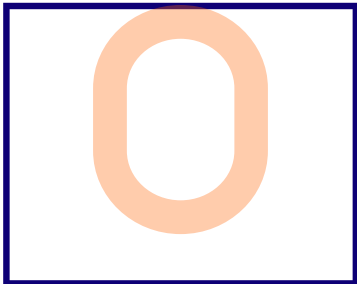

Car Rider Expectations

In an effort to keep all students safe and to ensure efficiency in the car rider line, we ask that you and your child follow these simple procedures:
