Screening for the Gifted & Talented Program in MNPS will take place in April and May 2021 for students in grades K-3 who were scheduled to be screened in the Spring of 2020 as well any student who met quantitative and qualitative criteria during the 2020-2021 school year. The Office of Gifted and Talented compiled an initial list of students using district and school data. This list will be provided to classroom teachers prior to the testing list being finalized.
