All medications must be taken into the clinic by a parent/guardian and must have a completed CCSD doctor's order form; meds must be in their original containers. Only life-saving emergency prescription medication may be carried and self-administered by students: rescue inhalers, epinephrine, and glucagon. *No other over-the-counter or prescription medication may be sent in with students or carried by students on school grounds or school buses*. All CCSD doctor order forms are available under the *Nursing Services* link of the main CCSD webpage.

As cold/flu season approaches, please continue to follow the 24 hour rule for fever or vomiting. Do not send your child to school with vomiting and/or a fever \geq 100.1 until fever-free (*without fever-reducing medication*) and no vomiting for 24 hours.
