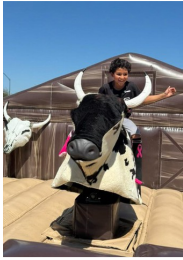

Did you know that our campus goal for daily attendance is 97.1% of students in attendance? Our March average daily attendance was 96.49%. We have been in school for a total of 135 days which is 60,750 minutes of school so far!

Parents can help promote good attendance by eliminating absences due to home activities, trips and family vacations which should be scheduled to coincide with non-school days. Arrival & Dismissal - Car Riders & Walkers

To help ensure a safe and smooth arrival and dismissal for all students, please review and follow our car rider and walker procedures:

Walkers and Bike Riders:

- Students are considered walkers and/or bike riders that walk or bike to and from school.
- Students that walk to their car are considered car riders. During arrival and dismissal times, do not park in the parking lot to drop off or pick up students. Use the designated car rider area located behind the school for arrival and dismissal.
- For dismissal, parents/guardians meet their child at the area outside the cafeteria.
- Students must use the crosswalks and follow the safety directions of the crossing guard.

Car Riders:

- Car riders are dropped off and picked up in the car lane behind the school.
- The front parking lot is not for dropping off or picking up students.
- The front car lane is for buses and students that require assistance from staff members.
- Display your dismissal tag clearly in your windshield each day.
- Students should enter and exit on the passenger side only.

Your cooperation helps keep arrival and dismissal safe, organized, and efficient for everyone. Thank you for partnering with us to prioritize student safety!

Credit By Exam

Credit by Exam (CBE) for Acceleration is one method for students to demonstrate proficiency in grade level or course content. The Texas Education Code allows students to either accelerate a grade level (K-5) or earn credit for a course (6-12) without prior instruction based on credit by examination.
