# TNReady Testing (3rd and 4th Grade)

This past Friday I shared a letter with information on the forthcoming TNReady testing. Every year, the state of Tennessee requires students in grades 3 through 12 to complete a standardized assessment. This year is especially unique due to COVID and the combination of virtual and in-person learning throughout the year. The state has shared that districts meeting the 80% participation rate will not be held accountable for testing results. At Eakin, our goal is for 100% of students to complete the assessment because the results provide valuable information that help us determine individual, grade level, and schoolwide instructional needs.

With that being said, we also understanding individual circumstances and feelings. We want every single one of our students to feel safe and supported in doing their best.
