Parents enrolling students in **Pre-Kindergarten** can begin the process online April 5, but they also have the option to register in-person at the Humble Civic Center, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Friday, April 9, or from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Friday, April 16. Nurse Notes

Wow, it's April already. How this year has flown by! I hope you parents are staying well and have the opportunity to get vaccinated for COVID-19. I look forward to the spring weather and sunshine.

That being said, it is still cool in the mornings (and inside the building) so please write your child's name on their jacket or sweater so we can return it to its rightful owner if misplaced.

As the days are getting warmer, and the summer clothes are coming out, parents should keep in mind the Humble ISD dress code (<u>http://humbleisd.net/Page/42</u>) when planning outfits for school.

A few highlights most appropriate for elementary school:

• Students at all grade levels may wear shorts, but "short shorts" are forbidden. The length of shorts must be between the knee and mid-thigh (usually to the tips of your fingers with arms down at your side).

• Students may not wear flip-flops or heels above one-half inch. Children go outside almost every day as long as it is not raining. Sneakers/Tennis shoes are really the safest shoes for PE and playing at school.

• Spaghetti straps, leotards and halters as an outer garment are not acceptable. Blouses covering tube tops must be buttoned.

• The midriff or bottom must not be exposed when a student goes through the normal activities of a school day, including bending, stretching or reaching.

We are still seeing illness from Coronavirus, as well as Strep throat and stomach bugs. Please remember to assess your children at home before sending to school. Humble ISD states students must be free from fever, vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hours before returning to school. Feel free to call the nurse if you have any questions.
