A Message from the Principal:

This week our attendance rate was down due to the fact that many students did not attend school on Monday and Tuesday due the Thanksgiving Break. While I certainly understand that students will need to miss school on occasion, students and parents need to make daily attendance to school a priority. Not only is there is a direct correlation to attendance and grades (the less days you miss the better your grades are), **those students who are absent from school in excess of 17 days in a school year (with the exception of COVID) will receive no credit in all subjects for the year.** Also, with it already being the 3rd week of our 2nd Marking Period, several of our students that were eligible for Grade Recoup are still working on getting assignments completed to improve their grade(s). Those students that were not as successful and failed a class might be eligible for GRADE RECOUP (50% to a 59.9%). If you earned an F with a percentage between 50% and 59.9% you NEED TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THIS OPPORTUNITY AND COMPLETE THE GRADE RECOUP BY DECEMBER 4th. 

School Attendance:

Unfortunately, our weekly attendance rate was down this week due to a number of students not attending school on Monday and Tuesday. Our goal is to have the best high school attendance rate for each month and I encourage our students to continue to make their attendance a priority. This is because our data shows that there is a direct link between student attendance and their GPA (the more days missed during a marking period, the lower your GPA will be). Poor attendance also does not only have a direct impact on academic performance, but it also reinforces negative habits that affect students once they graduate. Because of this, attending school on a regular basis will continue to be priority at Bohemia Manor High during the 2022-2023 school year.



While we certainly understand that this number will improve as the number of days increase and the number of absence decreases, please be reminded that any student that misses 17 days of school or more this year (regardless of the reason) will be in jeopardy of not earning credits for the classes they completed. Please continue to reinforce the importance of attending school on a regular basis with your student. If your student does need to be absent from school, they will need to provide our attendance secretary with a note stating their name, reason for being absent, and the date(s) in which they were absent once they return.

Twilight School:

With only a one week left in the first marking period, we encourage all those students that need extra support to take advantage of our Twilight School! Those students that need extra help, have a question, or need support completing/submitting an assignment can attend Twilight School from 2:45 and 4:45 on the assigned days. Twilight School is staffed daily with up to three teachers to help support students and will begin this week. Those students needed transportation home from Twilight School are able to ride a bus to one of the "Hub" locations listed below (approximate drop off times are also provided):


Wednesday Dismissal:

Our normal Wednesday dismissal time for our Middle and High School students is 2:55. However, due to the construction work that has been occurring on the Chesapeake City bridge, elementary buses have been extremely late arriving back to BMMHS from their early dismissal Wednesday runs. Until construction on the bridge is completed, we anticipate buses will continue to arrive late to our school on Wednesdays. 
GRADE RECOUP:

Starting on November 18th, any student that received a failing grade on their report card (with an average between 50% and 59.9%) will be able to complete grade recoup in order to improve to improve to a passing grade of a D (60%). It is extremely important that any student eligible for grade recoup takes advantage of this opportunity, as often times students that earn a failing grade in a class MP 1 have a difficult time passing that class for the year. Those students that are eligible for grade recoup need make sure that they meet with their teacher starting on November 18th.

FAFSA is the single most important thing a parent can do to get money for college (even if it's scholarship or merit money offered by a school). However in order to be able to fill out a FAFSA form, parents must first create their student's FAFSA ID.
