To this end, I am pleased to share that the District has partnered with Gaggle to implement a 24/7 SpeakUp safety tip line where students, parents, and community members can email, call, or text a concern about student safety issues and threats. In addition to this early-warning safety tip line, Gaggle proactively assists our District 24/7/365 in the prevention of harmful situations by providing real-time monitoring of electronic communications on MUSD school-provided technology. Through these proactive efforts, aligned with our security and internet safety measures, we can receive notifications of signs of self-harm, depression, thoughts of suicide, substance abuse, cyberbullying, and credible threats of violence against others.
