
Parents: Back to school usually brings lots of illness, anything from nasal congestion, sore throats, and GI illness. Of course, this year we are also concerned about the flu and Corona virus (COVID-19). Please remind your children to cover their mouths with their sleeves when coughing or sneezing. Frequent hand washing, social distancing, and wearing a mask are all ways to help stay healthy. Getting lots of rest, exercise, and eating healthy also helps to stay well. Flu season will be soon approaching. It's even more important this year to get your flu shot. Consider the flu shot for your entire family!

Illness: You should not send your child to school if he has had a fever (100 degrees or over), or vomiting and/or diarrhea in the last 24 hours. Please call the nurse to discuss these symptoms so we can make a plan of when to return to school or if your child needs to see a doctor before returning. If your child has seen a doctor for strep throat, ear infection, or conjunctivitis (pink eye), please let me know. He may return when he has been on antibiotics for 24 hours without symptoms, and feels well enough to stay at school. Please contact the nurse if your child or anyone in your family has tested positive for COVID-19. For more information on COVID-19 refer to my webpage or the Humble ISD website.

Other Health Concerns and Allergies: I look forward to talking with parents about any health concerns you may have with your child at school. I don't know all of our new students yet and want to make sure we can work together as a team to keep your child safe and healthy. Please call me if I have not reached out to you yet.

Medications: If your child will be taking **any** medication at school, prescription or over-the-counter, I must have a medication form completely filled out. Over-the-counter meds may be dispensed with only a parent signature if given on occasion. If this medication is needed more than 4 times a month or more than 10 days in a school year, a physician's signature is required on the form. **ALL medication** must be sent in with an adult in the original store package or with a pharmacy label. The medication policy can be found on the Humble ISD website. Medication forms need to be renewed annually. I have forms in the clinic or on my web page for anyone who needs one.
