LEARNING AND INSTRUCTION

Grades K-8 Students, last name A-M, will attend school on Mondays & Tuesdays. Students, last name N-Z, will attend school on Thursdays and Fridays. Students will have virtual days on the three days that they are not on school campus and may be grouped differently from their last name based on AIG, EC, or ESL status as well as siblings who may have different last names.

Grades 9-12 9-12 students will learn virtually Monday through Friday. High Schools will designate days to provide targeted support. High Schools will designate days for courses that do not lend themselves to virtual learning (Auto Tech, Band, Visual Arts, etc.)

All students will participate in a Virtual Learning Day on Wednesdays while every I-SS campus will have a deep cleaning day.

Students may also select a Complete Virtual Option.

TRANSPORTATION & MEALS

Modified bus transportation - parents are encouraged to transport when possible. Meals will be provided for any child in Iredell County.

As we move forward with Plan B, your child's school will be sending out more information specific to that campus.

Face Coverings:

Cloth face coverings are required for all students from Kindergarten through 12th Grade as well as Early College students in school and on buses, for all teachers, school staff, and adult visitors. We encourage students and staff to bring their own face coverings, but will provide face coverings if needed.

Screening:

Temperatures and health screenings will be taken each day at school for students and staff. Temperatures will not be taken prior to the bus ride.

Daily Routine:

All students and staff will practice social distancing as well as systematic hand washing. Students will still receive recess and breaks during their day. All staff members will report to work 5 days a week. PE classes will focus on personal fitness rather than group games to prevent the need to share equipment.

Transportation:

When able, parents and guardians are asked to provide transportation to and from school, as bussing will be limited. To align with state guidance, students will sit one student to a seat, unless seated with siblings and be required to wear a face covering unless there is a medical waiver.

School Nutrition:

All meals will be prewrapped. Meals will be available on virtual learning days at Nutrition Hubs throughout Iredell County.
